### Transportation

### **Public transportation**

Public transportation in Luxembourg is reliable and cheap. You can buy tickets on most buses from the driver (but there are a few exceptions, such as the airport bus, Line #16), from automated ticket kiosks (*points de vente*), or at the train station (*Gare Centrale*). The price is  $2 \in$  for a 2-hour ticket (*billet courte durée*) and  $4 \in$  for a day pass (*billet longue durée*). The tickets allow you access to all forms of public transportation within the country of Luxembourg, i.e. buses and trains.

The closest bus stop to the university is "Coudenhove-Kalergi". The bus lines # 1 and #16 (as well as several others) serve this stop. The second closest is "Konrad Adenauer" (less than 5 minutes' walk from the math department), served by bus line # 18.

### Plane

Findel Airport (the airport of Luxembourg) is 10 minutes away from Kirchberg; it is served by the bus line #16, which also stops at the university (bus stop "Coudenhove-Kalergi").

### Train

The train station (*Gare Centrale*) is well-connected by bus to every part of the city; in particular, you may take the lines #1 and #16 from there to the university (bus stop "Coudenhove-Kalergi").

### $\mathbf{Car}$

There is a very small gated parking lot next to Campus Kirchberg. We can open the gate for you (please come and find us during registration). However, it is usually extremely difficult to find a parking spot in this lot, and there is no other free parking near Campus Kirchberg.

### Registration

Registration for the workshop will take place in the main building of Campus Kirchberg, next to the main entrance, from 9:00-9:30 on the morning of Wednesday, December 9th, where you can pick up your badges and folders.
