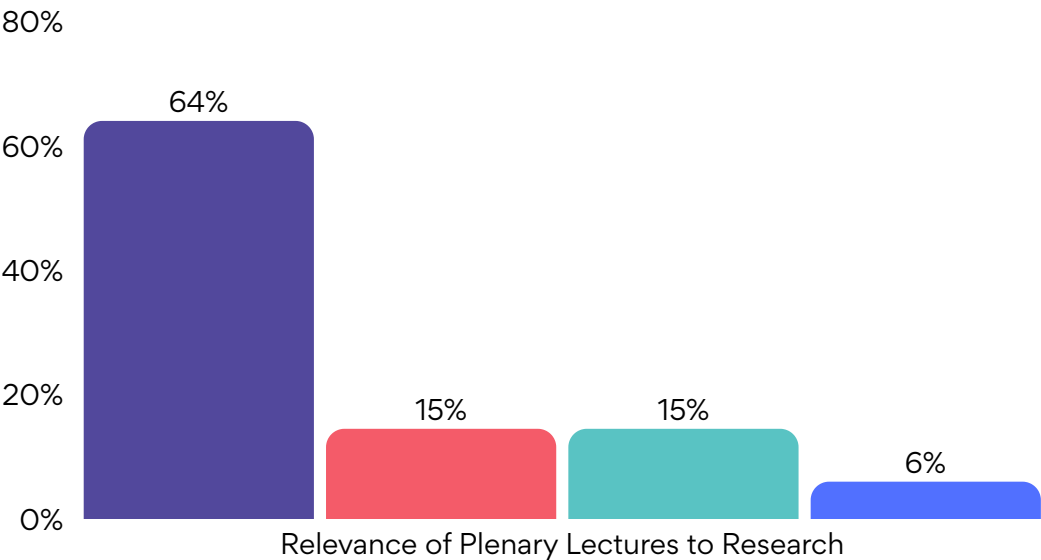




## Relevance of Plenary Lectures to Research

What do you think about the plenary lectures, relative to your research interests?

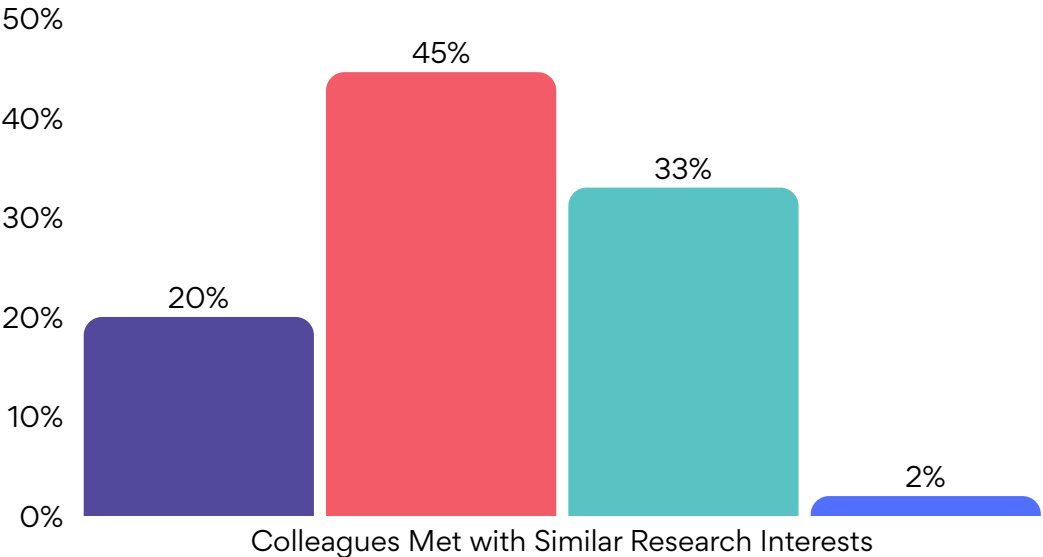


- More than one plenary talk fitted my research interests.

How many colleagues (approximatively) did you meet who match your research interests?

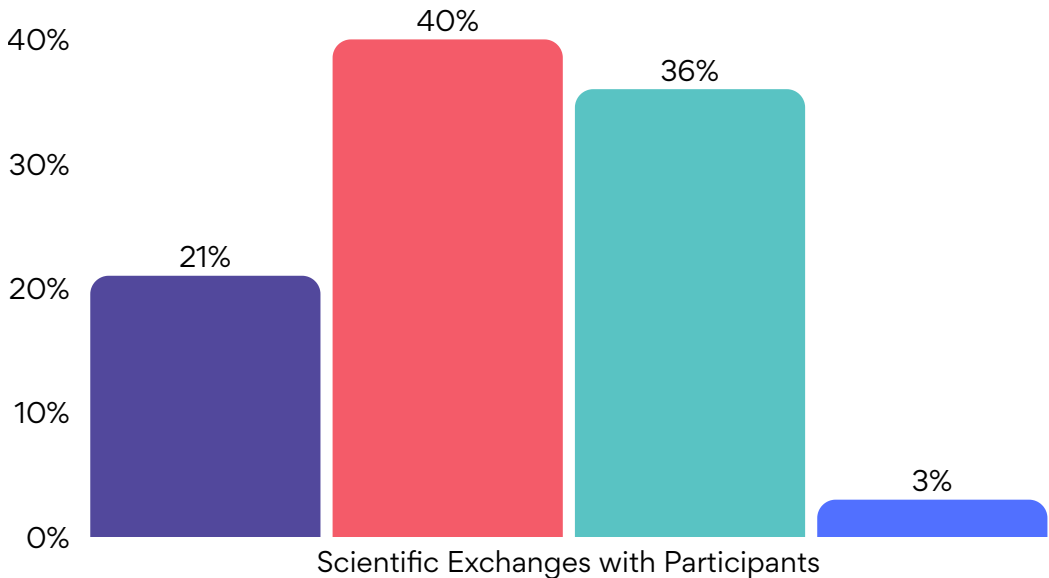


- More than 15

Did you have useful scientific exchanges with other participants?

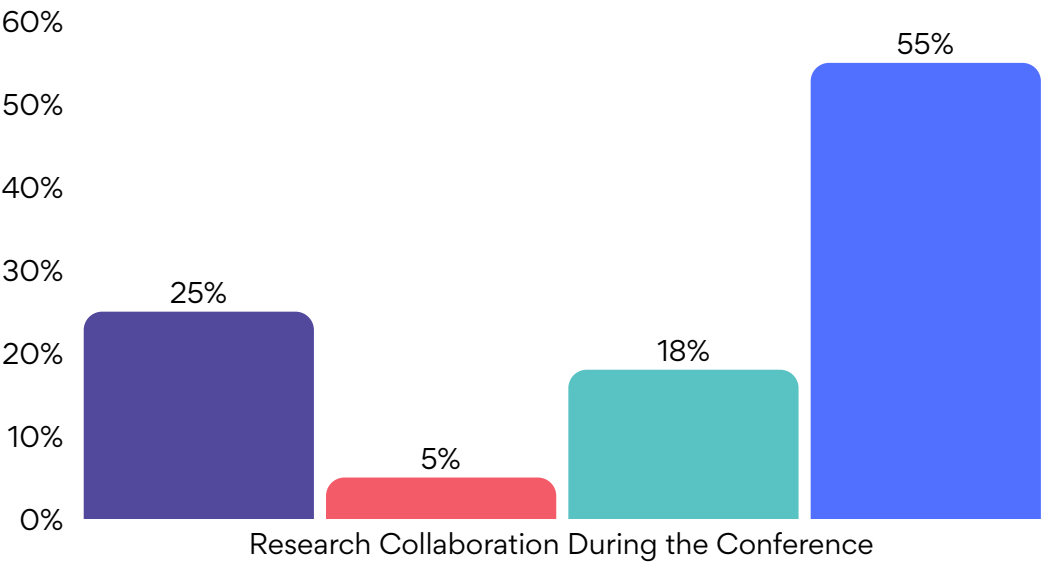


- Yes, very many

Did you collaborate on research during the conference with other participants?

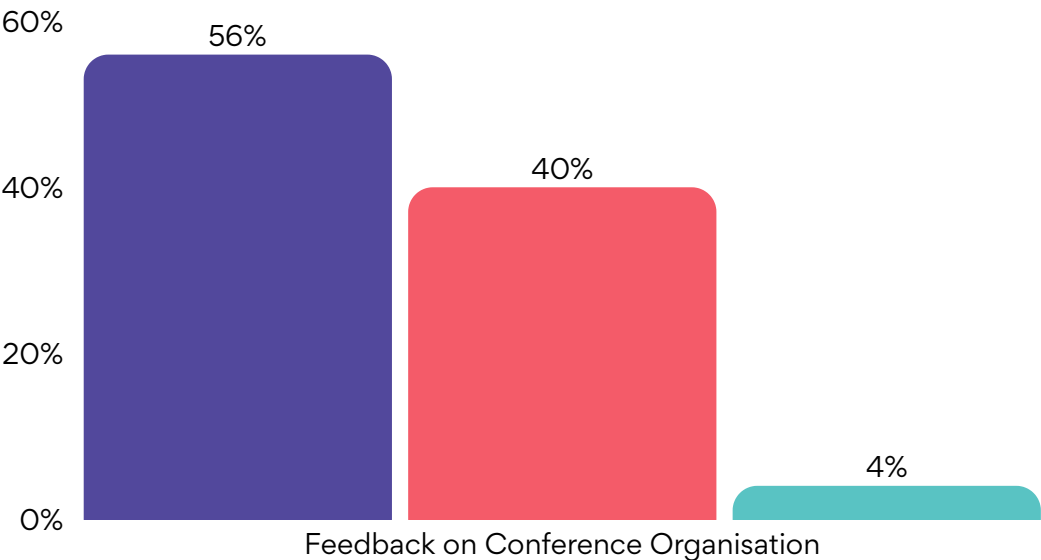


- I continued an ongoing collaboration.

What do you think about the overall organisation of the conference?

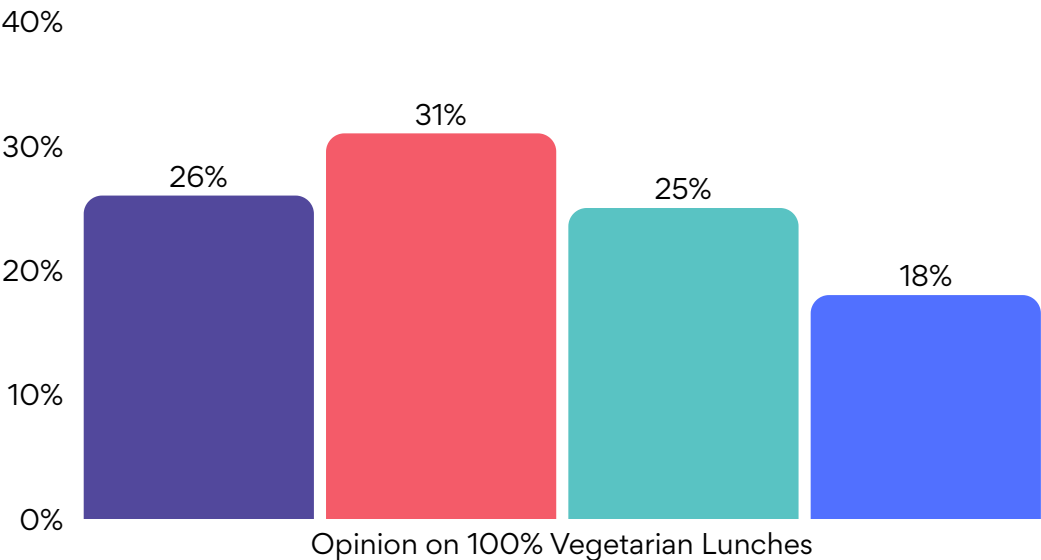


- extremely well organised

The JA25 lunches were 100% vegetarian. How do you feel about this choice?

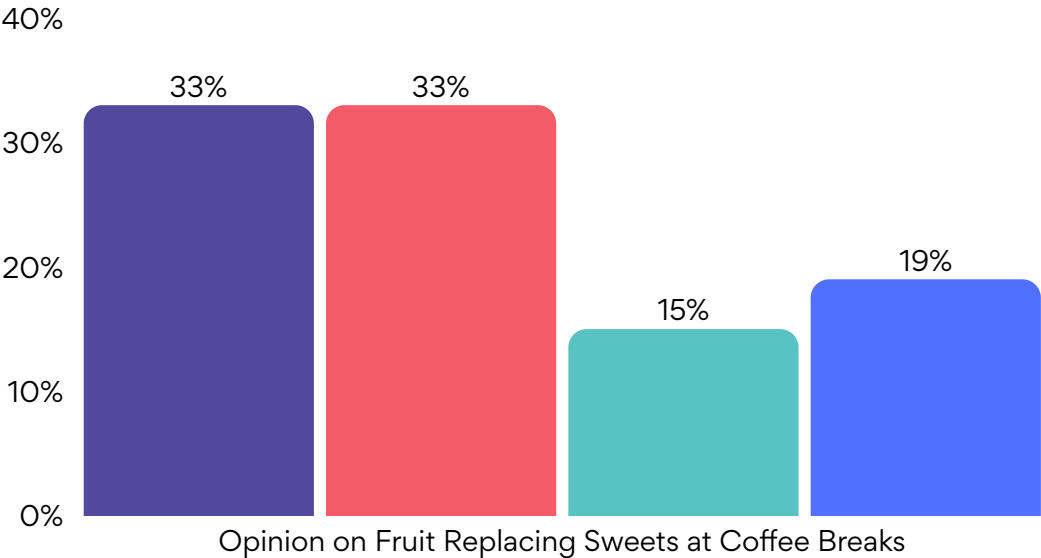


- Enthusiastic: every conference should be vegetarian
